



CLARIFICATION TEXT REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA (B-Stars Mobility Acceleration Program - Applicant)

5. Your Rights Regarding Personal Data

In accordance with Article 11 of the Law, the rights you have are as follows:

- You can learn whether your personal data is processed by our Company.
- If your personal data has been processed by our Company, you can request information about it.
- You can learn the purposes for which your personal data is processed and whether it is being used in accordance with those purposes.
- You can learn the third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred, both domestically and abroad.
- If your personal data is processed incompletely or inaccurately, you can request correction and ask for the correction to be communicated to third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred.
- If the reasons for processing your personal data, which have been processed in accordance with the relevant legislation, no longer exist, you can request its deletion or destruction, and ask for the communication of these changes to third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred.
- If your personal data is processed by our Company through automated systems and this results in an unfavorable outcome for you, you have the right to object to this result.
- If you suffer any damage due to the unlawful processing of your personal data, you can request compensation for the damages arising from unlawful processing.

Additionally, you may contact us in writing via the communication channels listed in section 1 above. We will respond to your request as soon as possible and no later than thirty days. As a rule, requests made by personal data owners are answered free of charge; however, in case of any additional costs, we reserve the right to charge you in accordance with the fee schedule determined by the Personal Data Protection Board.
